25 realities of homelessness & how YOU can change them...

Each morning, a homeless mother and her children wake up with no idea how they will survive the day, let alone where they'll sleep the next night. This is the reality of homelessness. Through your support of Beatitude House, YOU can change it.

Homeless parents often cut corners to try and make ends meet, sending their children to school without socks or underwear.

A gift of \$250 can purchase all the new clothes and supplies a Beatitude House child needs at back-to-school time.



Mothers may leave their children with relatives or friends to avoid them living on the street or being removed from their custody.

A degree is one of the last dreams for a woman with no place to sleep, yet her opportunities are curbed by a lack of education.

Utility debt is often a contributing factor to homelessness and remains a difficult expense for a family in poverty to sustain.

Homeless children are sick 4X as often as other children and the cost of medication is often weighed against the cost of eating.
